

# **FROM GLORY TO GLORY!**

There is a verse from the letter written to the church in Corinth, 2 Corinthians 3: 18 that says,

2 Corinthians 3:18

But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord. (NKJV)

Let me start this small monthly devotional this wonderful September by saying as simply as I can this. "If we're not trying, we're dying". You see it's is easy these days to become discouraged. I get discouraged often. It is easy to give up, to think that there is no peace, no strength, and maybe even go through a phase of losing hope. In my many years as a follower of Jesus Christ I have faced this battle many times, and not always with the results that I am proud of. Still, I have faced them just the same. Truth is the challenges we face, the changes, and even those things that we don't understand or like, none of it really matters if in the end all we do is give up.

I looked at this verse the other day and what came to my heart is how we view and accept those battles and challenges. For many of the Christians I know, including myself, it has been the kind of verse that gives me hope and tells that things are going to get better. Kind of like we are going from "mess to greatness", trying to find our confidence in knowing or believing that things will get better, things are going to change, you can win, stand your ground, hang in there. But honestly, is that what Paul is saying? That we are going from something that is less to something that is more? I do not think so. In fact I know so because what Paul is talking about has nothing to do with what we think is a mess but in fact says that we are going from "GLORY To GLORY". Read it again.

What Paul is talking about is a faith and trust that understands what it means to be content. Faith and trust that appreciates what one has, and is both grateful and thankful.

In other words it's about realizing that where we are is Glorious and then and only then can we go higher because the advancement if you will isn't from bad to worst or worst to better, it is from "Glory To Glory". In other words we are not to give in to thinking about what we don't have and what we don't like, our passion should be is seeing everything glorious.

There is a great worship song about this by David Crowder that says, Lord,

"You make everything glorious, You make everything glorious, You make everything glorious, and I am Yours, what does that make me"

Here's a thought: instead of praying God restore, how about we pray, Lord, show us Your glory, reveal Your glory in us.
